SECTION I - SWEET PEAS

1. NORTH HANTS SWEET PEA CHAMPIONSHIP. Collection of 3 vases, 9 spikes each vase, each vase a distinct cultivar.
2. Collection of 2 vases, 9 spikes each vase, each vase a distinct cultivar.
3. Vase 9 spikes, one cultivar, Blue, Lavender or Mauve.
4. Vase 9 spikes, one cultivar, white or Cream.
5. Vase 9 spikes, one cultivar, Pink.
6. Vase 9 spikes, one cultivar, any other colour.
7. Vase 12 spikes, not less than three cultivars.
8. Bowl, not more than 21 spikes, mixed cultivars, Sweet Pea foliage only allowed, own bowl. For quality and decorative effect.

SECTION II - ROSES

9. Vase of Large Flowered Roses, not more than 5 stems. (Hybrid T type)
10. Vase 3 stems Cluster Flowered Roses. (Floribunda type, 3 roses or more on the stem)
11. Specimen Bloom Large Flowered Rose. (Hybrid T type)
12. 1 Spray, Cluster Flowered Rose.
13. Vase 3 stems Large Flowered Roses at 3 stages of development.
'BUD, BLOOM, BLOWN' One Cultivar.
14. Vase Miniature rose, no more than 5 stems.
15. A bowl of Roses in own bowl.
16. Rose Buttonhole. Rose foliage only allowed.

NOTE - Large Flowered Roses may be exhibited with not more than three side buds (except specimen bloom).

SECTION III - KINGSCLERE RESIDENTS ONLY. Entry on the day. Own vases can be used.

17. Vase 5 spikes of Sweet Peas, foliage allowed.
18. Vase any type Rose, not more than 3 stems.
19. Single flowering stem excluding rose or sweet pea. Foliage can be included.
20. A pot plant
21. 2 of one kind of vegetable

SECTION IV - OTHER FLOWERS

22. Vase of Scented Flowers, 5 to 9 stems. Any variety/s.
23. Vase of Delphiniums, not more than three spikes.
24. Vase of one Kind of Flowers (not included in the schedule).
25. Vase of Flowers grown from seed during the preceding twelve months (Not including Sweet Peas).
26. Vase of Mixed Flowers (may include grasses and seed heads).
27. Vase of Shrub/s excluding Roses.
28. 5 Hosta leaves, may be displayed in own container.
29. Six Fuchsia heads, to be exhibited on board provided.
30. Six blooms of Pansies/Violas, to be exhibited on board provided or own container.
31. Pinks and/or Alwoodii. One vase, 5 stems, not disbudded.
32. Vase of Foliage.

SECTION V - POT PLANTS (Pots must not exceed 8in [21cm] in diameter except where stated)

33. Collection of two Pot Plants.
34. A Fuchsia, single flowered. (up to 12" (30cm) pot)
35. Any other Fuchsia. (up to 12" (30cm) pot)
36. A Regal Pelargonium/Geranium.
37. A Zonal Pelargonium/Geranium.
38. A Scented Leaf Pelargonium/Geranium.
39. Any other type of Pelargonium/Geranium.
40. An Orchid.
41. A Begonia Rex.
42. A Foliage plant, excluding Begonia Rex.
43. A Cactus.
44. An African Violet.
45. A Succulent.
46. Any other flowering plant, not included in classes 34 - 45.

SECTION VI - VEGETABLES

47. 5 Pods of Peas.
48. 2 Cabbages.
49. 2 Lettuce.
50. 5 Pods of Broad Beans.
51. 3 Potatoes.
52. 3 Sticks of Rhubarb.
53. Any other vegetable, minimum of 2, maximum of 5.
54. Vase of Herbs, 3 distinct kinds, three stems of each.

SECTION VII - SOFT FRUIT

55. Dish of 10 Raspberries with stalks.
56. Dish of 10 Gooseberries with stalks.
57. Dish of Blackcurrants, 10 strigs.
58. Dish of Strawberries with stalks, not exceeding 10 fruits.
59. Dish of any other fruit. Numbers optional.



SECTION VIII - FLORAL ART

Niches, 61cm (24in) wide by 76cm (30in) high will be provided for classes 60 and 61.

60. 'Rio'. An arrangement.
61. 'Lemon and Lime'. A foliage arrangement.
62. A petite exhibit using an egg cup, not exceeding 23cm (9in) in any direction.

SECTION IX - DOMESTIC

63. Lemon Drizzle Cake to recipe

Recipe:- 4oz soft margarine, 6oz castor sugar, 2 eggs, 4 tblsp milk, 6oz sieved SR Flour, 1 tsp baking powder, finely grated rind of 1 lemon.

Topping: - juice of 1 lemon, 2oz castor sugar.

Beat all the ingredients together until smooth and well blended. Turn the mixture into a lined and greased loaf tin and cook in a moderate oven 180 °C, 350 °F, gas mark 4 for 30mins.
Mix the lemon juice with the castor sugar and spread on the cake whilst it is still very hot.

64. Jar of Pickle or Chutney (State on label Hot or Mild).
65. Jar of Home-made Jam.
66. Jar of Marmalade.
67. 5 Ginger Biscuits to recipe

Recipe:- 8oz (200g) self raising flour, 2oz (50g) butter, 4oz (100g) sugar, 4oz (100g) golden syrup, 1 egg beaten, ½ tsp bicarbonate of soda, 2 heaped teaspoons of ground ginger.

Cream the butter and sugar. Add the syrup, then the beaten egg. Sprinkle the ginger and bicarbonate of soda over the mixture, add the flour and fold in. With flour dusted hands roll teaspoons of the mixture into balls and flatten slightly. Makes about 20 biscuits. Place on a greased baking tin and bake at 175°C, 350°F, gas mark 4, until dark golden brown. Remove and cool on a wire tray.

NOTE:- Cakes etc. must be covered by a clear polythene bag NOT cling film or any other bag and be at least 12 hours old. Jams and chutneys must be in clear glass jars with no commercial markings or lids and labelled with date of making.

72. A Soft Toy.
73. A Hand knitted article. (state size on entry form).
74. An article of needlework in silk or wool. (state size on entry form).
75. A painting or drawing not exceeding 20in by 20in (51cm x 51cm), 'A Local Scene'.
76. An item of Handicraft in wood, metal or plastic.
77. A handmade birthday card.
78. Any other item of handicraft.
79. A Photograph, 'A Nice Place to Sit'.
80. A Photograph, 'Anything that Floats'.
81. A Photograph, 'Fungi'.

NOTE:- Photographs may be coloured or monochrome, may be mounted, maximum size 5in by 7in (127mm x 178mm) excl. mounts.

SECTION XI - JUNIORS

Age 4-7 years

82. An original model made from LEGO, not to exceed 30cms in any direction

83. A picture made with petals

Age 8-11 years

84. An original model made from LEGO, not to exceed 30cms in any direction

85. A picture made with petals

Age 12-16 years
